Prisma Estúdio is a non-profit volunteer-run cultural association in the most diverse quarter of central Lisbon (Martim Moniz). Dedicated to the research, creation, and dissemination of the arts; our mission is to support emerging artists from diverse creative backgrounds, helping them to develop their practice and share their work. Drawing on the principles of research, creation, production, distribution and promotion of artistic and cultural events, to the benefit of our associates and Portugal.

Since 2019, our studio has been supporting artists from a diverse range of creative practices. We gained association status in February 2020 and have since collaborated with more than 60 artists – holding exhibitions, salons, workshops, poetry slams and arts & craft fairs. We have supported unrepresented artists to find revenue streams and throughout the pandemic provided a safe space for them to create, with our residency programme.

The collective creates and implements art projects, bringing together a vast list of contemporary international artists and partners interested in inviting art to traditional and alternative spaces. Our team seeks to connect artists with projects that best suit their talents, as well as places that can benefit from their unique gifts.



ABOUT PRISMA

The programme can host up to 4 artists at a time, we provide accommodation, a shared atelier space, access to support, and opportunities for collaboration with cultural actors in the city. The residency is run alongside our exhibition programme and schedule of cultural events in which residents are encouraged to participate and collaborate.

By becoming a resident you will be immersed in Lisbon's underground art community. Engaging in our diverse programme of events and collaborating with members of our community.

We welcome artists and organisers from diverse practices and backgrounds, researchers, curators, and critics for 1-3 months. We offer residents the possibility to explore techniques, concepts, ideas, and collaborations, to develop a final project while receiving curatorial guidance and support.

At the end of the programme, each resident will be offered the opportunity to exhibit their works in a final exhibition, publication, workshop, open studios, and/or performance in the gallery space in Prisma.



ABOUT THE RESIDENCY PROGRAM

OPEN CALL (2023)

Residency duration is for 1 to 3 months in the following dates below:

- JUNE (3rd - 30th June 2023)

- SEPTEMBER (3rd - 30th September 2023)
- OCTOBER (3rd - 31st October 2023)
- NOVEMBER (3rd - 30th November 2023)

The cost for each month of the residency is 700-800 euros (as the rooms are of different sizes there is a slight differentiation in prices).

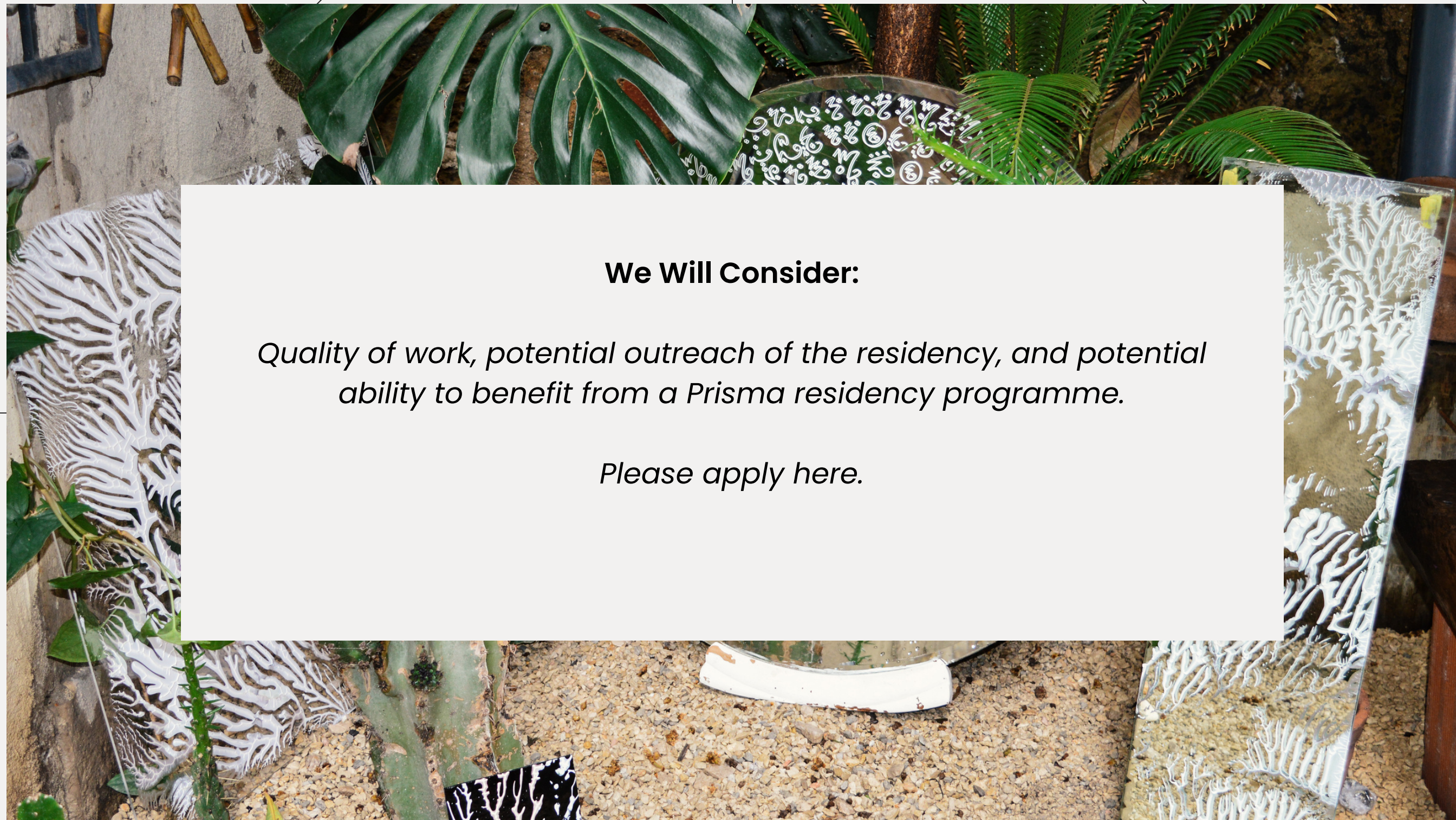


RESIDENCY INCLUDES:

- Artists-in-Residence will live in a shared apartment directly above the association with views of the castle, the apartment is fully furnished and shared spaces are cleaned weekly.
- Shared or private atelier space (42m²)
- 1-1 Consultations with curatorial advice
- Group Critique sessions
- Access to the program of events
- Final group or solo exhibition/showcase/workshop

APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE:

- Letter of motivation including a brief description of current practice, statement of intent, and goal of the residency (500 words max.)
- Please include preferred dates and duration
- Portfolio (max. 10MB total)
- Optional: letters of recommendation (3 max.)
- All applications should be written in English
